 "...who will by no means clear the guilty..." – Exodus 34:7

Colossians 1:3-4 (ESV)

³ We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, ⁴ since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love that you have for all the saints, Colossians 1:3-14 – "The God Whom We Worship" * Paul emphasizes the essential,

- foundational beliefs of the Christian faith
- Trinity, Deity of Christ, Virgin Birth, Atonement, Resurrection, Second Coming
- Basis for Apostle's/Nicene Creed?
- Typical for Paul to reiterate the gospel before then proceeding to doctrinal correction
- Ephesians 4, Philippians 2, Romans 1 8, Galatians 2, 2 Corinthians 5...

Colossians 1:3-14 – "The God Whom We Worship" Paul emphasizes the essential, foundational beliefs of the Christian faith Trinity, Deity of Christ, Atonement 1:3 "We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ...⁸ and has made known to us your love in the Spirit." -TRINITY 2:19 "For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell," – DEITY OF CHRIST

i:14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. - ATONEMENT

Colossians 1:5-8 (ESV)

⁵ because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel, ⁶ which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and increasing—as it also does among you, since the day you heard it and understood the grace of God in truth, ⁷ just as you learned it from Epaphras our beloved fellow servant. He is a faithful minister of Christ on your behalf⁸ and has made known to us your love in the Spirit.

Colossians 1:5-8 – "The God Whom We Worship"

- * "God is the Gospel." --- John Piper
- The message of the Christian faith is about God's desire to know us personally
- To save fallen, rebellious, sinful humanity by forgiving by grace
- God's holiness demands that He punish sin
- God desires for us to be reconciled so much that He Himself comes in the person of Jesus Christ to take that punishment and offer forgiveness to those who trust in Him for salvation 13/23

Gospel Summarized in the Five Solas of the Reformation **SOLA GRATIA – Only by grace SOLA FIDE – Only by faith SOLUS CHRISTUS – Only by Christ** SOLI DEO GLORIA – To God alone be the glory **SOLA SCRIPTURA – By Scripture alone**

Colossians 1:5-8 – "The God Whom We Worship" Paul emphasizes the correct understanding of who God is because a wrong understanding of God's character that He is only love, or that He is only judging – will change the gospel and endanger people's coming to Christ for salvation

 We see this in the Jehovah's Witnesses and Islam that reject Jesus' identity as God and then push works-based salvation
 The Prosperity Gospel de-emphasizes God's holiness so the message of the cross – the message of salvation – is lost.

Colossians 1:9-12 (ESV)

⁹ And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding ¹⁰ so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; ¹¹ being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy; ¹² giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.

Colossians 1:9-12 – "The God Whom We Worship" * This leads us to Paul's discussion of the works of the Holy Spirit

- JUSTIFICATION
- SANCTIFICATION
- ✤ EMPOWERMENT
- SLORIFICATION

These are important to understand how to grow in our relationship with Christ and be empowered by the Holy Spirit for ministry

Ephesians 2:8-10 (ESV)

⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Colossians 1:9-12 – "The God Whom We Worship" This leads us to Paul's discussion of the works of the Holy Spirit JUSTIFICATION – being declared righteous by grace, trusting in Christ's sacrificial death for salvation SANCTIFICATION – the inner work of the Holy Spirit, transforming us morally into the image of Christ and growing in the knowledge of God EMPOWERMENT – allowing the Holy Spirit to empower us for works of ministry **GLORIFICATION** – when we receive our resurrection bodies and are free from sin

Colossians 1:13-14 (ESV)

¹³ He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Colossians 1:13-14 – "The God Whom We Worship"

- Christ's death and resurrection are of cosmic significance for us His sacrifice defeated sin, death, and the works of the devil Paul will go on to develop these themes in the next chapter But Christ's atonement has lasting consequences on the
 - whole of reality

Colossians 1:3-14 – "The God Whom We Worship"

- Do you know the true living God who offers salvation through faith in Jesus, the Son of God?
- Is Christ's victory over sin, death, and the works of the devil a reality in your life?
- Are you allowing the Holy Spirit to transform you by growing in your relationship with God?
- Are you allowing the Holy Spirit to empower you in the ministries He has set before you to do?
