

Psalm 147: Praise the Lord The CALL to PRAISE


¹ Praise the LORD.

¹² Extol the LORD, Jerusalem; praise your God, Zion.


²⁰ Praise the LORD.

Psalm 147: REASONS for PRAISE GOD of CREATION The GOD who knows the stars 4-6

Understand, then, that those who have faith are children of Abraham. Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you." So those who rely on faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.



Psalm 147: REASONS for PRAISE GOD of CREATION The GOD who feeds the earth 7-11

⁷ Sing to the LORD with grateful praise; make music to our God on the harp. ⁸ He covers the sky with clouds; he supplies the earth with rain and makes grass grow on the hills. ⁹ He provides food for the cattle and for the young ravens when they call. Ohis pleasure is not in the strength of the horse, nor his delight in the legs of the warrior; 11 the LORD delights in those who fear him, who put their hope in his unfailing love.


¹³ He strengthens the bars of your gates and blesses your people within you.
