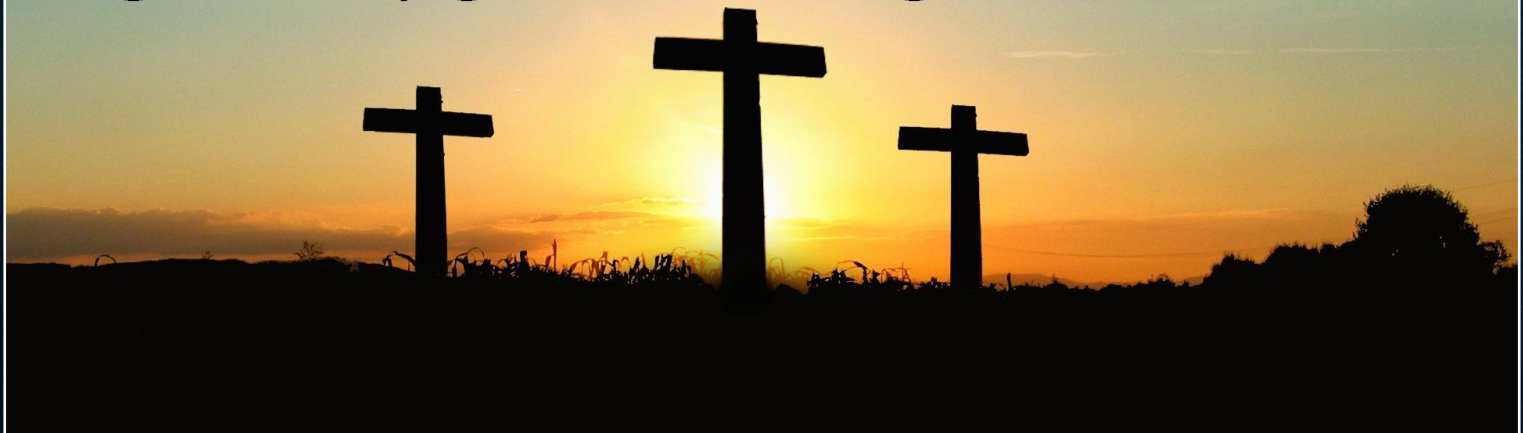


# GIVE US TODAY OUR DAILY BREAD

<sup>12</sup> Such people we command and urge in the Lord Jesus Christ to settle down and earn the bread they eat.

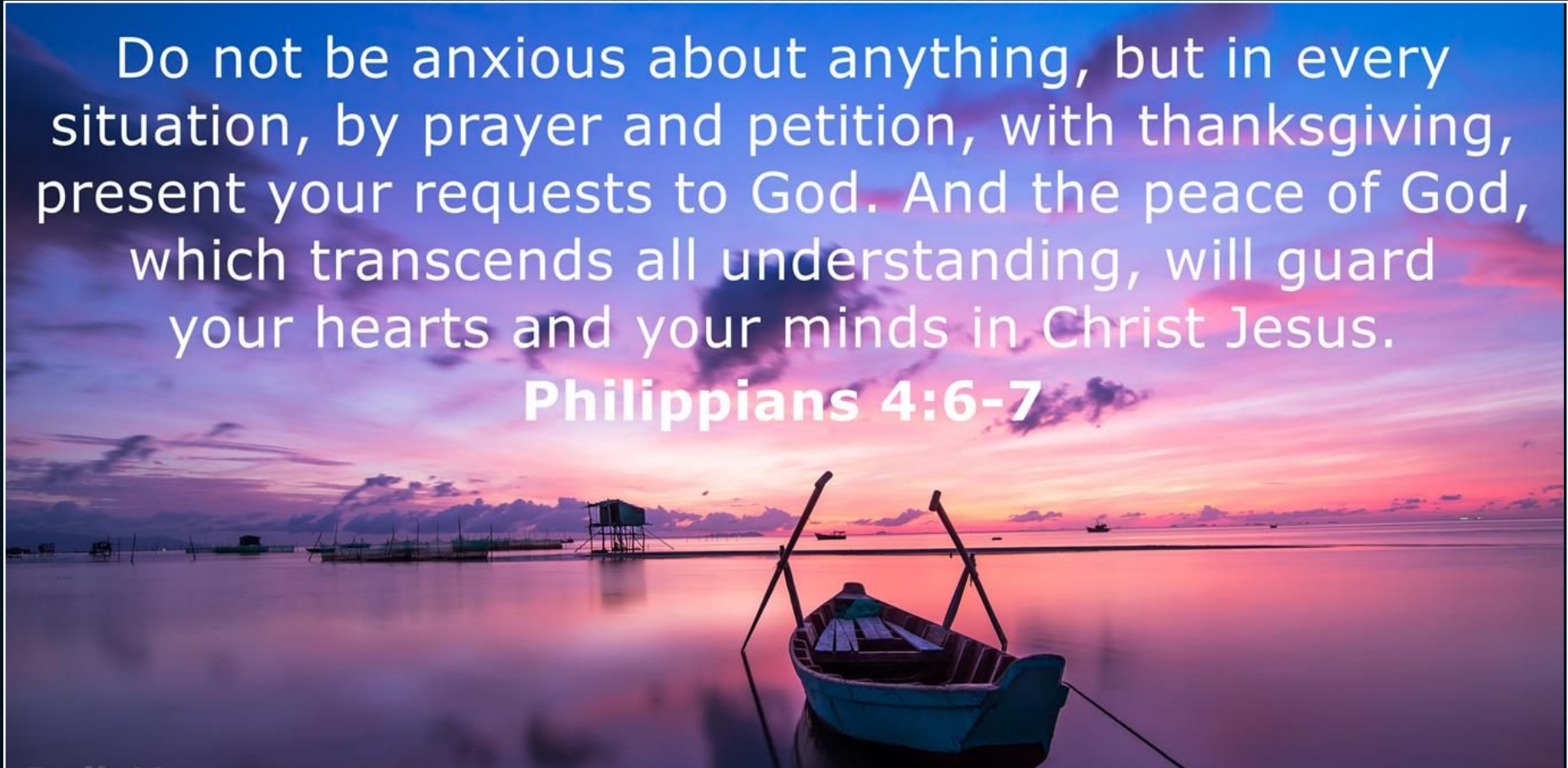


# “Give us today our daily bread”
