Commission and Ascension – ACTS 1:1-11

¹ In my former book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus began to do and to teach ² until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen. ³ After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God.

⁴ On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: 'Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. ⁵ For John baptised with water, but in a few days you will be baptised with the Holy Spirit.'

⁶ Then they gathered round him and asked him, 'Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?'



Convincing Proofs – ACTS 1:3

³ After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God.

- 2. Mary Magdalene (Mark 16:9-11; John 20:11-18)
- 3. Two travelers to Emmaus (Mark 16:12; Luke 24:13-32)
- 4. Peter in Jerusalem (Luke 24:34; I Cor. 15:5)
- 5. Ten disciples (Luke 24:36-43; John 20:19-23)
- 6. Eleven disciples (John 20:24-29; I Cor. 15:5)
- 7. Seven disciples fishing in Galilee (John 21:1-23)
- 8. Eleven disciples in Galilee (Matt. 28:16-20; Mark 16:14-18)
- 9. Five hundred persons (presumably in Galilee; I Cor. 15:6)
- 10. James, the brother of the Lord (I Cor. 15:7)

Kingdom of God – ACTS 1:3

The Gospel of Luke uses the phrase "Kingdom of God" 31 times. The book of Acts uses the phrase 6 times.

Bringing - Proclaiming

Wait for the Promise – ACTS 1:4-5

Still not Understanding - ACTS 1:6-7

'Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?'

You will receive Power – ACTS 1:8

⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.'




